The Commandant reminds all members that Marine Corps League uniforms must be worn according the Uniform Code of the League. The only ornament allowed on your League cover is the Marine Corps emblem...no other pins are appropriate. Khaki shirts are no longer a part of the uniform. NCO 'Blood Stripe' blue trousers may be worn with the short or long sleeve 'Undress' uniforms, are never to be worn with the scarlet blazer, but may be worn with the formal Mess jacket. It's imperative that members represent the League and the Marine Corps appropriately.
